Students who complete this program will obtain the expertise to use simple live public address (PA) equipment, edit audio files, use loops to compose/arrange music, assist in recording music, work at a music event and explore career options in the music industry.

VCAL: One credit towards a VCAL learning program is awarded on successful completion of 90 nominal hours of accredited VET curriculum.

VCE: Students who complete this program may be eligible for recognition of two units at units 1 & 2 level.

ATAR: This course contributes to ATAR if students continue into the Certificate III program following successful completion of the Cert II & selection into the Cert III program.

Please note: The student must already have English and three other fully scored VCE/VET subjects to create the primary four.
