Course Aims

Students who complete this program will obtain the expertise to use simple public address (PA) equipment (School assemblies & classroom setups), edit audio files, assist to record music in a recording studio, work at a music event and set up the stage for music performances (roadies).

Contribution to VCAL/VCE

VCAL: One credit towards a VCAL learning program is awarded on successful completion of 90 nominal hours of accredited VET curriculum. More credit is awarded for full completion.

VCE: Students who complete this program may be eligible for recognition of two units at units 1 & 2 level.

ATAR: This course contributes to ATAR if students continue into the Certificate III program following successful completion of the Cert II & selection into the Cert III program.
