

# SHB20216 Certificate II in Salon Assistant

This program provides students with the skills and knowledge at an entry level standard to enhance their career prospects within the hair and beauty industry.

#### **Course Aims**

Students who complete this training will be able to work safely under routine supervision including designing and applying make-up, for photography and remedial camouflage, and developing pedicure services, product knowledge and teamwork.

#### **Contribution to VCAL/VCE**

VCAL: One credit towards a VCAL learning program is awarded on successful completion of 90 nominal hours of accredited VET curriculum.

**VCE:** Students who complete this program may be eligible for recognition of two or more units at units 1 & 2 level.
