



## SHB20116 Certificate II in Retail Cosmetics with selected units from SHB30115 Certificate III in Beauty Services

This program provides students with the skills and knowledge at an entry level standard to enhance their career prospects within the beauty industry.

### Course Aims

Students who complete this training will be able to work safely under routine supervision including designing and applying make-up, for photography and remedial camouflage, and developing pedicure services, product knowledge and teamwork.

### Contribution to VCAL/VCE

**VCAL:** One credit towards a VCAL learning program is awarded on successful completion of 90 nominal hours of accredited VET curriculum.

**VCE:** Students who complete this program may be eligible for recognition of two or more units at units 1 & 2 level and a units 3 & 4 sequence.

**ATAR:** This subject does not have a study score and therefore cannot contribute towards the student's primary four. Where a units 3 & 4 sequence is available and satisfactorily completed, it may be counted as a 5th or 6th subject and contribute towards their ATAR (10% of the average of the primary four scaled).

*Please note: The student must already have English and three other fully scored VCE/VET subjects to create the primary four.*
