

RECONNECT: ENGAGEMENT & LEARNING SUPPORT PROGRAM

AGE GROUP 15 TO 24 | STATE FUNDING

Support for disengaged young people who leave school early and face multiple barriers to re-engaging in education and training and transitioning to the workforce or further training. The program assists by providing the individual wrap around services needed to successfully support young people back into education, training or employment.



ELIGIBILITY

- Aged 15 to 24 who have left school without completing Year 12 and are not in education, training or full time employment.

OR

- Aged 20 to 24 and completed Year 12 but have been unemployed or under-employed for more than 12 months.

COMMITMENT REQUIRED

- Be actively engaged with the Case Manager.
- Be willing to address any barriers to education or training participation.

SERVICES OFFERED

- ReConnect programs will assess the learning and non-learning needs and career goals of eligible young people and develop an agreed learning plan.
- Support will be provided to assist young people to commence and stay in vocational training.
- Supervised workplace experience will be arranged to increase employability, as well as the provision of support to assist students transitioning to employment or further training.
- 6 months' post-placement support.
